

## TORONTO/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6

Depart Toronto today on board your overnight transatlantic flight to Warsaw, arriving the following day.

#### **ARRIVE WARSAW**

#### WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7

Arrive today in Warsaw, the sprawling capital of Poland. You will be met and escorted to your waiting motor-coach for the transfer to your hotel. (D)

#### WARSAW

#### THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8

Though all but destroyed during World War II, Warsaw is a living monument to the spirit of its people. The lovingly restored Old Town is a symbol of the Poles determination to preserve their heritage. It is the true heart of the city, dating from the 14th century, and combines a mixture of renaissance and baroque buildings. Here you will walk along the cobbled streets and visit the beautiful Market Square. Other highlights include Chopin's Monument and the Warsaw Ghetto. The afternoon is free to explore the city on your own. (B,D)

## WARSAW/CZESTOCHOWA/AUSCHWITZ/KRAKOW FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 9

Drive south today to Czestochowa, renowned for the Jasna Gora Monastery, which twice withstood the onslaught of overwhelming Swedish forces during the religious wars of the 17th century. It is home to the Black Madonna, the "Queen of Poland," which has become the country's national symbol. After your visit continue to the Auschwitz Concentration Camp—a frightening reminder of the Holocaust. After your visit, continue to Krakow, Poland's ancient capital and once home to Polish kings. (B,D)

## KRAKOW/WADOWICE/KRAKOW SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10

The morning takes you to Wadowice, the birthplace of Fr. Karol Wojtyla, later known as Pope Saint John Paul II.

Return to Krakow for your afternoon city tour. See the 16th century Wawel Royal Castle whose magnificent arcades have earned it the nickname "Poland's Acropolis." On to St. Mary's Church and the Old Town. Time permitting, visit the Shrine of the Divine Mercy before returning to your hotel. (B,D)

#### **KRAKOW/PRAGUE**

#### SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 11

Depart Krakow and cross the Czech border. Drive through the verdant farmlands of Bohemia to historic 1,000 year old city of Prague. Located on the Vltava River, Prague is considered one of the most beautiful capitals in Europe. (B,D)

#### **PRAGUE**

#### **MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12**

Begin your morning tour with a visit to Our Lady of Victory Church to view the famous statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague. Next, tour Hradcany Castle, the seat of power for several Czech princes and kings. Proceed to the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, the Romanesque Basilica of St. George, and Mala Strana (Lesser Town), whose winding streets are lined with small taverns and old houses. Continue to Old Town to see the ancient Town Hall with its animated astronomical clock. (B)



#### PRAGUE/MUNICH

#### **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13**

This morning drive to Munich, the capital of Bavaria. Munich was ruled for over 650 years by the Wittelsbacher dukes and kings, who left their mark on the architecture and founded the world famous Munich art collection. See Marienplatz, the central square in the city center of Munich since the year 1158. View Nymphenburg, the former Royal Residence, Odeon Square with the beautiful Theatiner Church and the Hall of Generals. Overnight in the Munich area. (B)

### MUNICH/NEUSCHWANSTEIN/OBERAMMERGAU WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

Ascend the Bavarian Alps and view Mad King Ludwig's fairytale Neuschwanstein Castle, one of the most photographed palaces in the world and the model for the castles at the Walt Disney theme parks. Next visit the oval rococo Wies Church designed in the late 1740s. On to Oberammergau, site of the world famous Passion Play.

## THE PASSION PLAY OF OBERAMMERGAU THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15

The highlight of your trip! In keeping with their 389-year old promise, the villagers of Oberammergau present their Passion Play depicting the last week of the life of Christ. The play's presentation can be traced to 1633 when the Black Plague swept Europe. The people of Oberammergau took a solemn oath: if God spared them, they would present a day-long play depicting the last week in the life of Christ. To this day they have kept their promise and every ten years the citizens of Oberammergau perform their passion play with the same love and devotion they have shown for over 380 years. Today the play takes place on an open-air stage with a covered auditorium seating 4,700, against a beautiful backdrop of towering Alpine mountains. (B,D)

### OBERAMMERGAU/MUNICH/TORONTO FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 16

All too soon your pilgrimage is over as you transfer to the airport and board your return flight home to Toronto, arriving the same day. (B)
